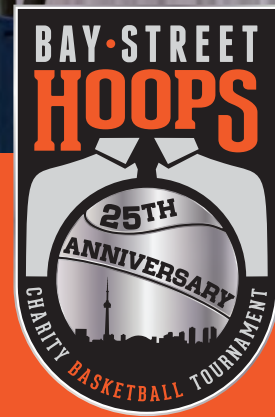

The tournament is hosted at the University of Toronto, and offers playing levels from recreational to competitive.

Since 2002, over 600 kids have participated in the program. Many graduates of this program return home to train, coach and mentor; becoming positive role models in their community.



THE TOURNAMENT

Through the generous support of our sponsors, each team will be entitled to play in a three-game, full court, 5-on-5 round robin tournament, with experienced referees. Games are expected to last approximately one hour.

The top teams advance to the playoffs with a chance to win a division trophy and fabulous championship prizes. Each team will receive a team kit that includes 12 jerseys and tickets to the post-game party.

Teams can choose to participate in the division appropriate to their skill levels, including:
